CASE STUDY

“My victory over adversity”

“I am Muhammad Ayub. My family and I live in Cox's Bazar. Our family fled persecution in Myanmar seven years ago, and came to Bangladesh.

I found it quite difficult to contribute to our income because of my physical impairment.

Then RDRS Bangladesh (ALWS' local partner) came into our camp and met me. They graciously gave me three birds, and useful training in vegetable gardening and raising poultry.

My quest toward financial stability began with this support. I actively increased the size of my poultry farming operations.

I began growing a range of vegetables, such as tomatoes, eggplants, bottle gourds, and chili peppers, which greatly increased my income.

I even managed to buy two ducks thanks to my determination, which increased my income potential.

I'm really proud of what I have done and hope to now fulfil my dream of opening a modest grocery store to represent my victory over adversity.”
