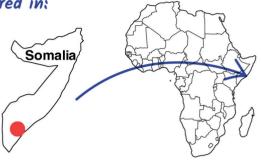

Why your help is needed	 Years of conflict means millions of people have had to flee their homes More than 4 million Somalis now live in IDP Camps (IDP = Internally Displaced Person - like a refugee, but in your home country) Here, families rely on food aid In rural areas, drought means livestock die and crops don't grow 70% of people live on less than \$2 a day all of which means more than 1.5 million children are malnourished
How your gift changes lives	 Children have the nutrition they need for growing bodies There is less risk of stunting, and they can concentrate at school They have the best chance to get a quality education so in the future they can break free from the cycle of poverty!

38-year-old Mumina and her family live in this makeshift shelter. Forced to flee their village when it was no longer safe, they have almost nothing. On top of this, Mumina's son was born with a disability...



Mumina's story: "I am hopeful things will change"

"My son was born with deformities both in his hands and legs. I have been struggling with barely anything to put on the table...

...but everything happens with God's permission.

One day, a knock on our door by some people from LWF shone a bright light into our lives.

They told us about the Centre where my son could go.

Khalif's deformities severely affected his daily lifestyle but the LWF staff gave me hope that these deformities may be improved through physiotherapy.

So I am hopeful things will change for the better.

I also learnt some home-based care for my child including gentle massage, and hand and legs exercises. This has been greatly helpful.

Following three weeks of continuous physiotherapy sessions, Khalif is now able to hold objects firmly with both hands.

His weight has also started improving.

I am also supported with dry ration porridge as a supplement to the nutritional needs of my family.

It's packed with vitamins and always comes at the right time for us. Now, my son and family are in good health and back in the healthy growth range.

We normally receive the dry ration on monthly basis.

The porridge is especially helpful to us during the lean season, when our vulnerable family have completely depleted our food stocks and have no other income.

My son has improved in terms of diet and nutrition since taking the porridge.

I am really thankful to ALWS and LWF for providing us with the fortified porridge which has been on our table every month.

It has been a substitute many times when we have no other food around."
