



"Now I am free!"

"My name is Matiop. I used to be a successful farmer with cows, sheep and goats.

Unfortunately, many years ago, a flood came. It destroyed my farm and killed all my animals.

Our land has been submerged under water since then.

I was left with nothing but starvation.

Life became much worse. My children had to stop going to school and my family was starving.

I was in a terrible way.

I moved to the river to fish for survival, and began fishing with one spear to feed my family.

Then you came, and supported me with fishing net and hooks through LWF.

My life began to improve - all because of your help through LWF to start up my life.

I started to have surplus from fishing, which meant I could catch enough fish to take to market.

The canoe has improved my fishing, because I can row deep into the river for a better catch.

I also learned preservation methods. I do smoke, salt and sun-dry to preserve my fish for the market, and I now sell fish wholesale.

With the profits, I have managed to send all my five children to school, and bought a few goats.

Now I can provide for my family. I'm proud of my hard work and give thanks to you. I am really grateful!

My desire is for my children to have a better life...

...to study well, to have good health in body and spirit, to grow into better people for tomorrow, to marry with children and lead a good life. I pray for this.

I am grateful to the people who support me.

May God bless their helping hands so as to continue helping those that are in dire need. May God uplift them!"

South Sudan is one of the poorest countries in the world, ranking 192 out of 193 countries on the UN Human Development Index.

Civil war and prolonged floods, coupled with periods of drought, threaten the fragile social system. This creates huge challenges, both for people's livelihoods and their food security.

In fact, two thirds of people in South Sudan do not know where their next meal will come from.

At the same time, millions of displaced South Sudanese are returning home to rebuild their lives and their country. They desperately need sustainble sources of income.

Women are especially vulnerable as they are often forced to work dangerous jobs to support their family.

This includes jobs like gathering firewood and making charcoal, which mean they are often alone in the forest at night and at risk of attack or even rape.

All this means your action to invest in people in South Sudan is especially precious. Your gift shows extra care to those in danger of being forgotten.

Despite a peace agreement being signed in 2018, the situation in South Sudan remains challenging. Alongside outbreaks of conflict is the damage caused by major flooding. At the same time, people still long to return to South Sudan to places where there are pockets of peace and stability. ALWS supports an **integrated**, **community-based empowerment** and **rights-based approach** while working as part of a **global partnership**.



Taking an integrated approach to development work means working across different sectors. For example, if you build a school, but there's no road to get there, housing for teachers, or clean water, the school won't be very useful!



A **community-based empowerment approach** gives people the training and support to make their own decisions about the development in their community. This means they then have responsibility for the activities, and grow the confidence needed to become self-sufficient.



A **rights-based approach** recognises community members as rights-holders. Your support empowers people to claim their rights, while at the same time, develop the capacity of those in power to meet their obligations.



ALWS is part of the LWF (Lutheran World Federation) **global partnership.** Working in partnership means we share expertise and resources, so people receive the best support available, and we're efficient and effective.


